

KENTUCKY MASTER LOGGER PROGRAM

Kentucky Master Logger Program is required by law - the Kentucky Forest Conservation Act requires that at least one graduate of the KY Master Logger (KML) Program on site and in charge of each commercial logging operation (excluding horse logging). The law also requires the use of bmp's on all commercial logging operations. The KML Program is held 9:00am to 5:00pm local time. To successfully complete the KML program you must attend and participate in all three days. Each program is limited to 50 participants.

Note: all values are expressed for unsawn logs delivered to the mill in dollars per 1000 board feet (mbf) as estimated by the Doyle log rule unless otherwise noted.


