Putney Recreation Trail Lease Signing

Frankfort, Ky. (October 21, 2016) – Harlan County Government and the Division of Forestry are entering into a lease agreement to utilize approximately 10.6 acres located in two areas of Kentenia State Forest for the construction of a recreational trail and the restoration of Goss Park. The new trail will connect to Little Shepherd Trail (which connects to the Great Eastern Trail <http://www.greateasterntrail.net/maps-trail-descriptions/kentucky/>) and Goss Park Camping area on the crest of Pine Mountain. The recreation trail will be open to horseback riding, hiking and bicyclists; no OHVs. An inaugural trail ride by horse will happen in May of 2017.
